BOARD ELECTION

The Board-appointed Nominating Committee has provided the Board Secretary with its list of Board and Supervisory Committee candidates. Nominations may also be made by PHCU members by means of petition containing the signatures of at least 50 members. To be valid, nominations by petition must be submitted with brief biographical data of the candidate and a signed certificate from the nominee stating that he/she is agreeable to the nomination and will serve if elected to office. Nomination forms may be obtained at any PHCU branch location or by calling (803) 978-2101 option 5.

The deadline for submitting nominations by petition to the credit union's corporate office is Monday, November 13, 2023. Please note nominations will not be taken from the floor at the annual meeting.

The election will be by means of a mail or email ballot. Ballots will be sent to PHCU members only if there are more candidates nominated than vacant seats on the Board or Supervisory Committee.
